ARE WE MAKING ANY COVID-19 PROGRESS HERE?

The Texas Medical Center would like you to know how they are gauging our progress daily in the fight against COVID-19. They publish graphics and information to help the ten-county region understand just where we are excelling in the fight and where we are coming up short. The three main metrics that they focus on are: effective reproduction rate, daily new cases and test positivity rates.

Fortunately, the News Continues to Improve in an Up/Down Kind of Way!

Effective Reproduction Rate is .87 -- day 1 with a rate below 1.0. Community control is defined as less than 1.0 for 15 days.

Test Positivity Rates are at 2.8% -- day 76 with a rate less than 5% -- down from last month. Community control is defined as less than 5% for 14 days -- we've come a long, long way.

Daily New Cases is still the area in which we need the most work. Community control is less than 200 new cases per day for 14 days. We are at 279 new cases in the 10-county region for the last 24-hour period. That's definitely down a bit from our last report. Good news, right?

Key takeaways for 6/7/2021:

-- The 14-day average of new cases in Harris County reported within 14 days of the test date is 27.5 new cases per 100,000 residents. Our goal to reach before moving to Green is 10 new cases per 100,000 residents.

-- The 14-day average of positive tests is 5.0%.

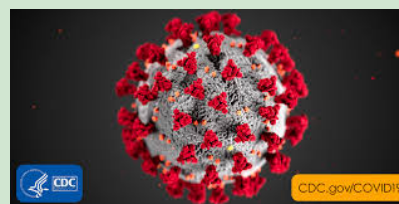
-- The 14-day average of the COVID-19 ICU population is 8.7% of capacity. Our goal to reach before moving to Green is 5%.

-- The 14-day trends for both COVID, COVID General Population and ICU Population are negative, indicating that more COVID-19 patients are leaving the ICU and general hospital population than are going in.

Additional Information:

The total number of COVID-19 deaths in Harris County is 6,480, according to the Department of State Health Services (DSHS). The death rate per 100k population is 137.5, which is higher than 14 states.
